Instructions

1. Chain 4 and join to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc 11 in ring, join.
3. Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each dc around, join.
4. Round 3: Ch 3, 3 dc in next dc, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc*, repeat * around, join.
5. Round 4: Ch 3, 4 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
6. Round 5: Ch 3, 5 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
7. Round 6: Ch 3, 6 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
8. Round 7: Ch 3, 7 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.

9. Round 8: Ch 3, 8 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
10. Round 9: Ch 3, 9 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
11. Round 10: Ch 3, 10 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
12. Round 11: Ch 3, 11 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
13. Round 12: Ch 3, 12 dc in next ch-1 space, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next ch-1 space*, repeat * around, join.
14. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Tips

- If you want to make a larger tree skirt, simply add more rounds to the pattern.
- You can use any color of yarn you like to match your holiday décor.
- If you're new to crochet, there are plenty of resources available online and in libraries to help you get started.

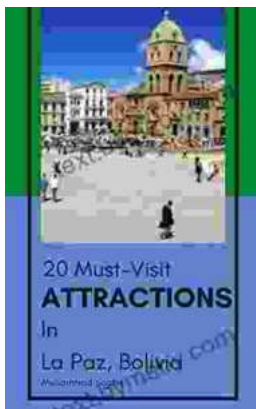

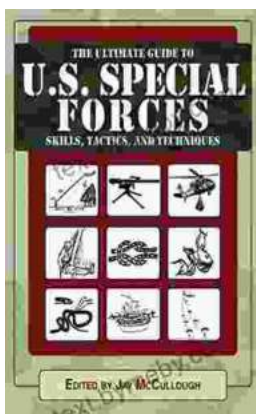
