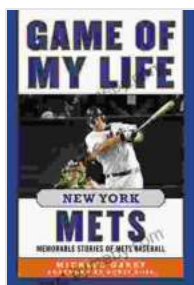

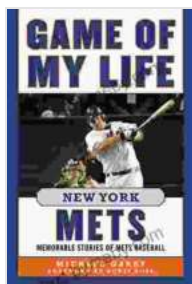
The Mets went on to win the game 5-3, and they eventually won the World Series in five games. Wright's grand slam was one of the most memorable moments in Mets history.
