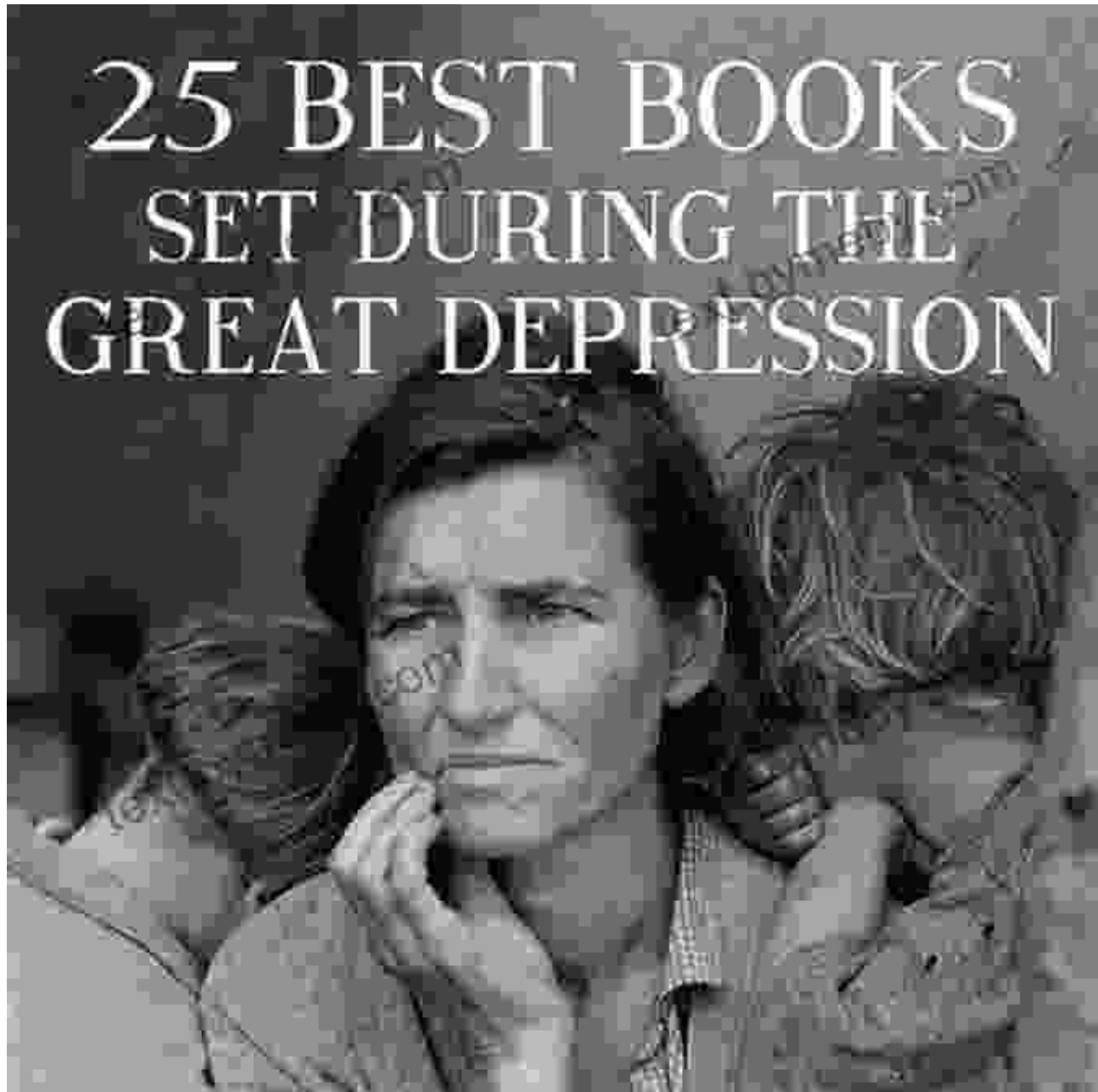
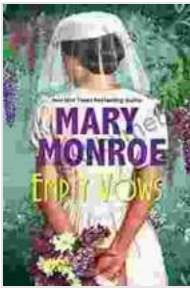

Scottish author, journalist, and philanthropist. She is best known for her children's books, including *The Harry Potter* series.

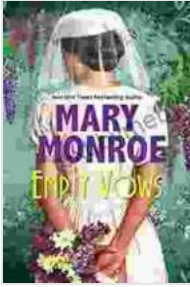

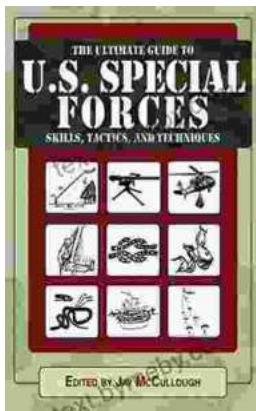
