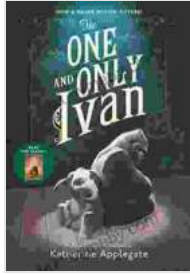

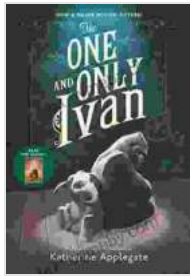
Ivan's Legacy
