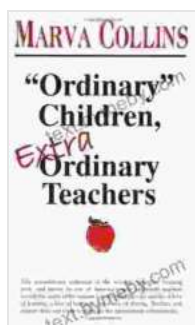


Ordinary Children, Extraordinary Teachers: The Marva Collins Story

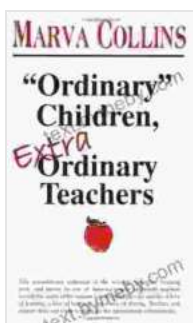

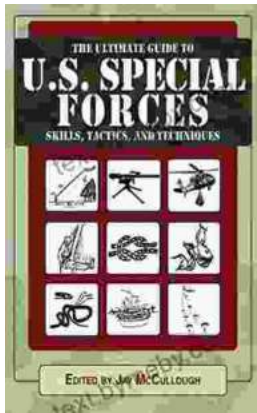
