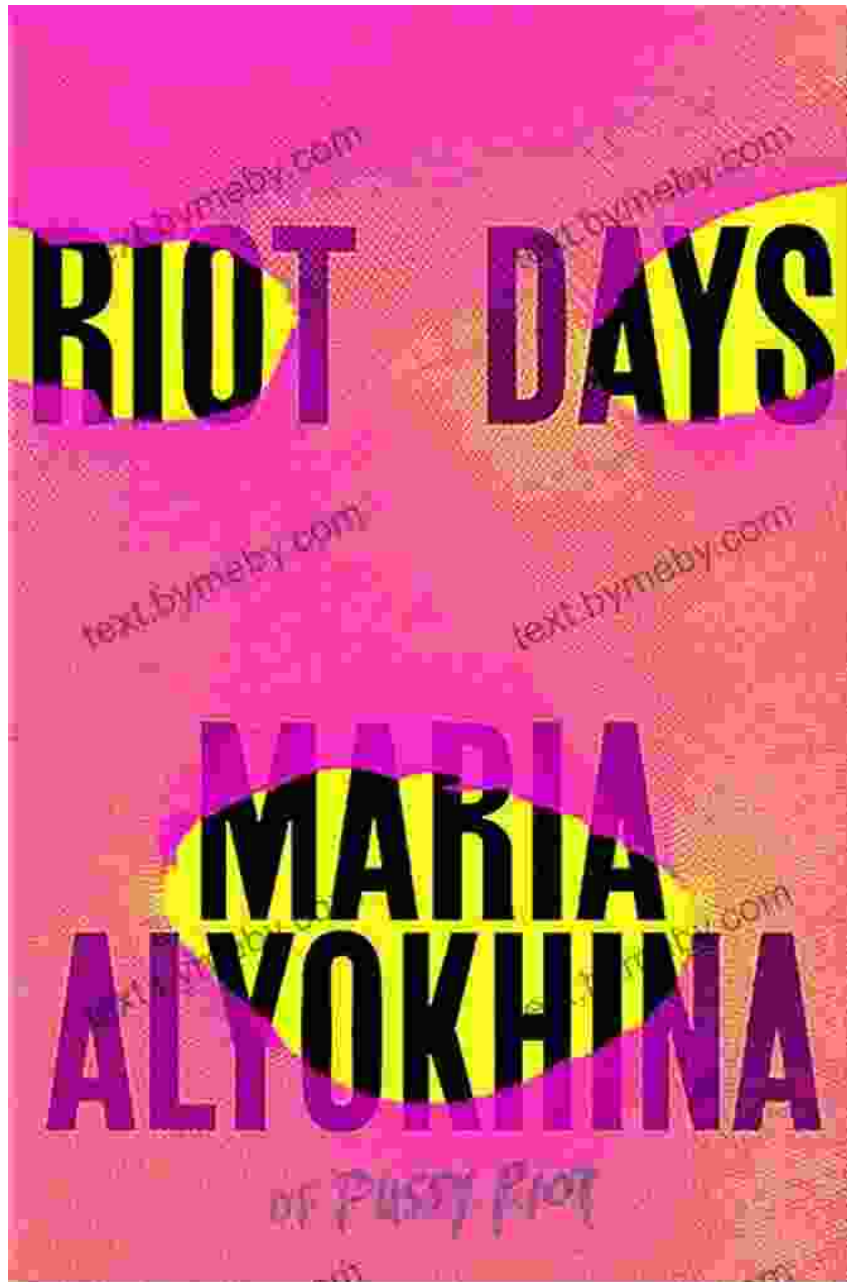


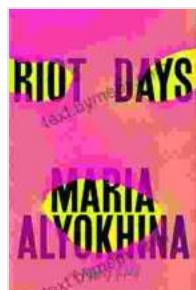
Riot Days: A Raw and Riveting Account of Resistance from the Heart of Pussy Riot

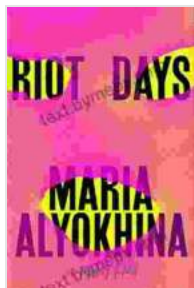

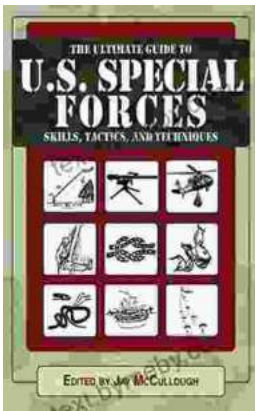
