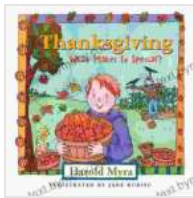


Thanksgiving: What Makes It Special?

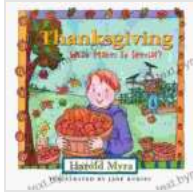

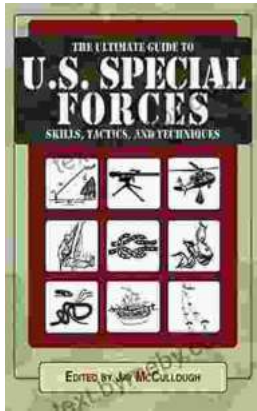
